CENTURIS - PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

Centuris respects your privacy. As a decentralized finance (DeFi) protocol, we are committed to minimizing the collection of personal data. This Privacy Policy explains how we handle information when you interact with our dApp.

2. Information We Do Not Collect

Centuris is designed to be permissionless. We **do not** require you to create an account, provide your name, email address, physical address, or any standard personally identifiable information (PII) to use the core features of the Protocol. We do not perform KYC (Know Your Customer) checks.

3. Information We Collect (Blockchain Data)

When you connect your wallet to the Centuris dApp, we collect public information necessary to facilitate your transactions:

- **Public Wallet Address:** Used to read your token balances and execute smart contract interactions.
- **Transaction History:** Data recorded on the public blockchain regarding your interactions with the Centuris smart contracts.
- **Note:** Blockchain data is inherently public and permanent. Anyone can view transactions associated with your wallet address on a block explorer.

4. Technical Data (Cookies & Analytics)

We may collect basic, anonymized technical data to ensure the dApp functions correctly (e.g., browser type, RPC node connection status). We do not use intrusive tracking cookies for advertising purposes.

5. Third-Party Services

The Centuris dApp relies on third-party infrastructure (such as blockchain RPC providers like Alchemy or wallet providers like MetaMask). Your interactions with these services are governed by their respective privacy policies.

6. Security

While we do not store personal data on centralized servers, the security of your funds depends on your own management of your private keys and wallet seed phrases. Centuris cannot recover lost or stolen funds resulting from compromised user wallets.
