### CENTURIS - TERMS OF SERVICE

#### 1. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing or using the Centuris platform (the "dApp"), the smart contracts, and any associated services (collectively, the "Protocol"), you agree to be bound by these Terms of Service. If you do not agree to these terms, do not use the Protocol.

#### 2. Nature of the Protocol

Centuris is a decentralized finance (DeFi) application operating on the blockchain. The Protocol allows users to mint and burn the \$TOPX index token and interact with the \$CTS governance token. Centuris is a non-custodial platform. We do not have access to your funds, private keys, or wallets.

#### 3. Assumption of Risk

You explicitly acknowledge and assume all risks associated with using the Protocol, including but not limited to:

- **Smart Contract Risk:** The underlying code may contain bugs, vulnerabilities, or errors that could result in the total loss of your funds.
- **Market Volatility:** Crypto assets are highly volatile. The value of \$TOPX and \$CTS can fluctuate significantly.
- **No Guarantee of Redemption:** While the \$CTS token may be supported by a Treasury of Real World Assets (RWAs) or other cryptocurrencies, Centuris does not legally guarantee any buybacks, redemptions, or price floors. The Treasury operates algorithmically and at the discretion of the Protocol's governance.
